### **Eligibility Criteria**:

- 1. Must be a scheduled caste student
- 2. Nationality Indian Citizen
- 3. Only those Scheduled Cast (SC) candidates who have already completed their Graduation are eligible for applying to admission in this UPSC coaching 2022-23, in case of final year appearing candidate, he/she must produce graduation completion certificate at the time of admission.
- 4. Age limit minimum 21 years and maximum 37 years as on 1.10.2022

#### **Documents required (Scanned copy)**

- 1. Photograph
- 2. Age proof
- 3. Scheduled Caste certificate
- 4. Educational qualification of highest degree

#### General terms and conditions:

- 1. Coaching will include (a) classes on general studies, CSAT and selected optional papers, (b)Test series, answer's evaluation, and essay writing practice shall part of the curriculum.
- 2. In order to be considered for admission into the desired courses, candidates must have graduate of a recognised University.
- 3. The Scheme is open only to SC candidates. University shall obtain/verify requisite caste certificate from the concerned candidate / student/ issued by the competent authorities in his/her respective States/UTs or as the case may be.

- 4. The coaching benefits under the scheme may only be utilized by a student once regardless of the number of chances that he/she may be entitled to in a particular Competitive Examination. The student must submit to the University an affidavit stating that he/she has not received any monetary benefit from any of the other scheme by Government of India, State/UTs or any funding agency.
- 5. The candidates enrolled under this scheme shall have to attend all the classes. In case of remaining absent for more than 15 days without any valid reason, or leaving the coaching midway without prior approval of the competent authority, the total expenditure incurred on the candidate will be recovered from the student/candidate concerned.
- 6. A total of 100 (hundred) seats are available for coaching in GGV. 33% of the available seats for coaching may preferably be given to the eligible female candidates of SC category. In case the sufficient number of eligible female candidates does not apply, University may allocate the vacant seats to the other male/transgender candidates (SC candidates only).
- 7. The University will maintain attendance registers for all candidates enrolled for the coaching classes as well as subject-wise results of practice tests, or any other evaluation.

# IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING IN ONLINE PROCTORED TEST

- 1. The Entrance test will be conducted online on proctored mode by Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (Central University), Bilaspur (C.G.).
- 2. Syllabus for Entrance Test
  - i. General Studies (50 Marks)- Indian, History, Geography, Indian Polity, Indian Economy, General Science including Science and Technology, Current Affairs, Sports and General Knowledge.
  - ii. General English (25 Marks)
  - iii. Numerical Ability and Reasoning (25 Marks)
  - The total duration of the test would be two hours.
- 3. The entrance test paper would consist of objective type questions. There would be 100 questions, and the total marks would be  $100(100 \times 1=100)$ .
- 4. Guidelines and method of answering is available separately. Candidates have to comply the instructions and attend a minimum of ONE mock test session to make themselves familiar with the process beforehand.
- 5. Candidates will appear in online entrance test through their own Desktop Computer/Laptop/Mobile or from a place of their choice. There will be no prescribed test centre. Candidates would be able to take the test from a place of their choice. They must however ensure that the place in which the test is being taken must have proper lighting and no one else should enter the same during the entire duration of the test.
- 6. Candidates are advised not to come to GGV campus for this test.
- 7. For the benefit of the students Demo / Mock test sessions would be scheduled. It is both advisable & mandatory for Candidates to attend a minimum of ONE mock test session to make themselves familiar with the process beforehand. The schedule of the same and complete guidelines for Online Proctored Entrance Test would be shortly made available on <a href="https://www.ggu.ac.in/dace.aspx">https://www.ggu.ac.in/dace.aspx</a>
- 8. Before submitting online application forms read the instructions carefully. Mere appearance in the Online Entrance Test or inclusion of name in the merit list does not

entitle a candidate to be considered for admission to a course unless he/she fulfils the prescribed eligibility conditions as mentioned above.

- 9. Other relevant important instructions are available separately. The Entrance Examination of a candidate shall be cancelled if the candidate is found to be indulge in unfair practices/suspicious acts in any form or will found to be in violation of any of the rules/guidelines issued in this regard.
- 10. A person found to impersonate a candidate may be handed over to the Police under an FIR lodged by the Vishwavidyalaya. The candidate in reference shall be debarred from future Tests of the Vishwavidyalaya.
- 11. No scrutiny/re-evaluation of online responses of Online Test is allowed in any case at any stage.
- 12. Please do not send print out of online application form to Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya. Candidates are advised to keep a copy of application form with them for future purposes.
- 13. The closing date and Entrance Test date is tentative and it can be extended if the Government of India or regulatory bodies issued any direction in this regard or the situation so arises.
- 14. No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates for appearing in the examination/counselling online or offline admission, as the case may be.
- 15. DACE will select the students and will give admission to the applicants on the basis of marks scored in Entrance Test conducted by the University.
- 16. Candidates are advised to read all instructions guidelines issued by DACE/GGV before submitting of application form and appearing in online entrance test. DACE, GGV will not responsible for any technical fault and will not entertain any excuse from any candidate.
