INTRODUCTION

India is a treasure house of biodiversity in its various ecological condition, rich ethnic diversity and vast traditional knowledge base forming a Botanical Garden consisting of 16 Agro climatic zones and 45000 different plant species. More than 8000 species are used in about 10,000 herbal drug formulations. Among all the Indian states, Chhattisgarh is the paradise for herbs used in Ayush sector. More than 1525 medicinal valued plant species are available in Chhattisgarh and many of them are of greater medicinal importance. Still the knowledge regarding their authentication, scientific validity of the ethnomedical claims and toxic interactions is inadequate and needs further knowledge in full spectrum. There are large numbers of Vidyas and Baigas (About 880 Baigas have been registered) all over the Chhattisgarh State, most of them treat tribal people with the locally available medicinal plants. In view of its extremely rich and unique bio-cultural-diversity, the Government has resolved to develop Chhattisgarh as Herbal State. There have been several medicinal plants which are used by the local Vaidraj for the treatment of various diseases and many of them have neither been scientifically authenticated nor any systematic research been undertaken to validate the therapeutical potential of these plants. National Seminar on "Ethnomedicine and New Drug Discovery: Opportunities and Challenges" would provide a platform for the researchers, academicians, industrialists and traditional healers to come together for sharing their knowledge and experiences.

MAJOR OBJECTIVES

- To simulate scientific temperament among researchers and academicians by exchanging ideas, thoughts with the experts.
- Facilitate the dissemination of scientific knowledge among all delegates of the nation.
- Propagate the application of herbal drugs & their medicinal value.
- Enhance the academia-research interaction towards science sensitization.
