

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya is named after Saint Guru Ghasidas (1756-1836), a visionary social reformer. Guru Ghasidas founded Satnam Panth, a socio-religious sect, which challenged contemporary discriminatory social order and advocated for social equality by refuting the exploitative and hierarchical caste system. With his holistic vision and systematic reforms, Guru Ghasidas contributed significantly in removing the prevailing social injustice and inequality.

Satnam Panth believes that truth is God and there is only one God, which is formless (nirgun) and infinite (anant). Individual reformation was brought by prohibiting consumption of liquor and non-vegetarian food. Guru Ghasidas also formulated principles, which show his love for fauna and his desire to put an end to cruelty towards animals. The partisans of Satnam Panth have been following these dictates from last hundreds of years now.

After its upgradation into a central university, many steps have been taken by the University authorities to translate Guruji's philosophy into reality. Now, our campus is an alcohol and tobacco free campus. Our vibrant university campus, where students from diverse castes, creeds and classes come together from all over India, provides an egalitarian environment based on Guruji's teachings.



Admission Procedure / General Instructions

- 1. Applications Invited: The Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE), Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (GGV), invites online applications for various programs (Online Mode) approved by the Distance Education Bureau (DEB), UGC, for the Academic Session 2025-26.
- 2. Eligibility for International Applicants: Applicants from foreign countries are also eligible to apply.
- 3. DEB ID Requirement: It is mandatory to create a DEB ID and ABC ID while filling out the online application form.
- 4. Application Guidelines: Guidelines for submitting the online application form are available on the university website (www.new.ggu.ac.in). Applicants are advised to read the instructions carefully before submitting the form. Please note that submitting the online application does not guarantee admission to a program unless the candidate meets the prescribed eligibility criteria.
- 5. Age Limit: PG Programs: Minimum 19 years (As of 01 July, 2025), No upper age limit, UG Programs: Minimum 16 years (As of 01 July, 2025), No upper age limit.
- 6. Fee Structure and Other Details: Information regarding the fee structure, admission procedure, syllabus, etc., is available on the university website (www.new.ggu.ac.in).

 Applicants should click the CDOE link available on the university website for specific details and updates.
- 7. Seats Availability: There are no limitations on the number of seats; seats are unlimited for all programs.

ADMISSION DETAILS

- (i) Relaxation in Minimum Eligibility for SC, ST, and PWD Categories: All SC, ST, and PWD candidates who have passed the qualifying examination are eligible for admission, regardless of their percentage of marks.
- (ii) Relaxation in Upper Age Limit for Reserved Categories:
- There is a 5-year relaxation in the upper age limit for SC, ST, and PWD candidates.
- OBC candidates are granted a 3-year relaxation in the upper age limit wherever it is prescribed.
- (iii) Relaxation for Wards of Kashmiri Migrants: Admission relaxation will be provided based on the instructions issued by UGC / MoE.
- (iv) Minimum Percentage Requirement: If a candidate's aggregate percentage of marks in the qualifying examination falls below the stipulated minimum, their provisional admission will be automatically canceled.
- 8. Refund Policy: Refund if any, will be as per UGC/University rules.
- 9. Jurisdiction for Disputes: Any disputes related to admission at Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya will be subject to the jurisdiction of Bilaspur courts only.

Campus

- Our university's green campus features 61 tree species, 2 MW solar power generation, and rich biodiversity, including migratory birds, butterflies, dragonflies, lizards, mammals, and amphibians, emphasizing our commitment to environmental sustainability.
- With over 292,000 square meters under plantation, bamboo initiatives, and the annual planting of over 25,000 plants, we actively reduce our carbon footprint, which was 957.12 metric tons in 2023.
- Promoting eco-friendly transportation, we provide 210 bicycles and battery-operated shuttles for students, further supporting our green campus initiative.



Library



- Our Well-Stocked Central Library located in main campus caters the needs and exigencies of the students, teachers and Research scholars.
- The cavernous building can accommodate more than 500 people at a time and inventory of 188394 books, 400 back volume of journals, 947 Ph.D. thesis.
- Internet and Wi-Fi services are also free of cost.
- UGC INFLIBNET and INDEST consortia services are also made available.

Women's Studies Development Centre

- Women's Studies development centre is the first of its kind in the state and was entrenched in 2005.
- The centre concentrates on the raising consciousness and knowledge of gender equality and equity issues through participatory activities



Facilities in the Campus

Computer Centre

- The University has modernized computer centre with several versions of Linux and Windows operating systems to compliment computer literacy.
- A large number of peripherals such as printers, LCD projectors, scanners and other multimedia devices are handy for users.
- The internet connection is provided to all.
- It also maintains University website www.ggu.ac.in which provides all the relevant information and notifications regarding the University's happenings.





Health Centre

- Health facilities are available for students and residents of the campus under the able guidance of a Medical Officer and other visiting specialist, as per needs.
- Specialist from CIMS also visit the health center in the campus from time to time for specialized checkup & advice.

Proctorial Board

- The university has constituted a Proctorial Board for keeping its campus well disciplined.
- The Board takes prompt action in case of any misconduct if occurs in the campus and recommends appropriate punishment for students found guilty.
- It also takes all the preventive measures against ragging and examines the cases of alleged ragging (if any).
- All the students are required to submit an undertaking to the proctorial board as not to be involved in any type of misconduct at the time
 of admission.

Hostel Facilities

- Six hostels, three for boys and three for girls separately, provide accommodation to 800 approx boys and 800 girls.
- Vishwavidyalaya faculty member acts as Warden and supervises each hostel.
- The University aims to provide a comfortable lodging and boarding services to the students keeping in view a home away from the home.
- Admission in hostels is based on merit as per University rules and the students will be required to apply in the prescribed application form.
- In view of the limited hostel facilities available, the candidates may please note that the grant of admission to a course of a study in the UTD would not automatically entitle one for allotment of hostel accommodation and that the application of the students for hostel allotment will be considered if seats in the hostel are available.
- Hostel residents are expected to observe the rules and regulations prescribed for them as well as all the requirements of corporate life and the social norms that living together demands.
- Failure to observe discipline or violation of rules may make a student liable to disciplinary action which may result in the withdrawal of Hostel Facilities.

- Cheating in examination and supplying of false documents / information in order to seek any consideration / favour from the University.
- Possession or consumption of intoxicating beverages on the campus.
- . Failure to return back loaned material, settle University dues.
- Possession of weapons.
- . Use of unparliamentarily language while in conversation with Vishwavidyalaya Staff and fellow students.

Disciplinary Actions

Failure to adhere to good conduct may result in disciplinary actions like:

- A warning by the authorities.
- Suspension from a particular class.
- Suspension / expulsion from the University.
- Suspension of campus privileges e.g. hostel, accommodation etc.
