Regulation for award of B.Tech. degree under NEP 2020

**Proposed Amendment in the Existing Ordinance
Clause 4.4 under eligibility for B.Tech. with Honors / Research 4.4.1
&4.4.2**

(f) Only those students, who have a CGPA of 7.5 or above, without any backlog, and minimum 75% attendance maintained in each registered course/paper, will be permitted to register for an Honors degree.


(k) Honors degree shall not be awarded at any circumstance without completing the B. Tech. programme.

(l) Deleted

Clause 7.0 Attendance and Eligibility to Appear in the Examination

A Student shall be required to attend at least 75% of the classes actually held in each theory course/paper, seminars, practical, projects, as may be prescribed. Provided that the Dean of the School of Engineering and Technology on the recommendation of the concerned Head of the Department may condone the shortage in attendance of those students who have secured at least 65% attendance in each subject/course/paper/practical/seminar/projects. This condonation should not exceed 10% on the following satisfactory grounds.

7.1 A student who does not satisfy the requirement of attendance as per clause above, he/she will not be allowed to register/appear in the end semester examination of that particular course/paper (in which



his/her attendance is less than minimum requirement i.e. with condonation 65% and without condonation 75%) during that semester. However, he/she can appear for the rest of the courses/papers in the end semester examination. Further, no student will be detained due to lack of fulfilling the minimum attendance requirement in any semester as per the above clause and all will be promoted to next higher semester. But the students who were having shortage of attendance in any subject/course/paper in the previous semester, he/she must re-register for the same course by paying extra fee and complete the requirements of minimum attendance and examination in the next higher semester (as and when the department offers) along with the regular courses registered in the current semester (higher semester).

10.5 Deleted

Clause 10.6 Basis of Subjects Evaluation

10.6.5. For passing a subject the student is required to fulfill the following conditions:

- (b) Must have scored minimum SGPA of 5.0 in the semester. If a student has cleared all the Theory and Practical subjects of one or and both semesters of a year, but has failed to secure SGPA of 5.0 in the semester or and semesters of a year then he/she will be



allowed to re-appear in the forthcoming examination in those subjects in which the student's Grade Points less than 5.

Clause 11.0 Promotion to Next Year and Semester

11.1 The promotion policy from one semester to next higher semester as follows.

- (a) Any student admitted in a programme shall be promoted to the next higher semester only after successfully completing the attendance criteria.
- (b) A student in any semester may opt for a maximum of 40 credits for appearing in the end semester examination, which includes the current and backlog subject/ paper/course of the semester.
- (c) The last/final semester result will be declared only after the successfully completing/passing cleared of all backlog papers/courses/subject.
- (d) Any student will have the opportunity to clear the backlog of previous semesters subject to the following two conditions:
 - (i). That the total credit in which the student is appearing in the end semester exam should not exceed 40 credits in any case.
 - (ii). The examination will be conducted twice in a year (odd and even semesters). Students will only be allowed to register

current/backlog subjects/courses/papers in the respective ongoing semester/examination.

(e) Students opting to appear in the backlog courses in any semester have to fill the additional examination form along with the prescribed fee as notified by the University from time to time.

11.2 If any deviation/changes in the curriculum (curriculum at the time of admission), the committee constituted by the department shall decide to regularize their courses in align with the current academic curriculum with the regular students.
