

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

Drug discovery is the process aimed at identifying therapeutically useful compounds for the cure and treatment of disease. This process includes candidate identification, synthesis, characterization, validation, optimization, screening, and testing of therapeutic efficacy. Once these studies demonstrate the compound's importance, the drug development process begins prior to clinical trials. The drug development process must go through several stages to produce a drug that is safe, effective and meets all regulatory requirements. A common theme of our articles is that the process is so lengthy, complex and expensive that many biological targets need to be considered for any new drug that will ultimately be approved for clinical use. New research tools may need to be evaluated to explore new targets. The journey from initial discovery to marketed drug is a long and arduous task. From discovery to approved drug takes about 12 to 15 years and requires an investment of about \$1 billion.
