








INSPIRATION



GURU GHASIDAS JI

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya is named after Saint Guru Ghasidas (1756-1836), a visionary social reformer. Guru Ghasidas founded Satnam Panth, a socio-religious sect, which challenged contemporary discriminatory social order and advocated for social equality by refuting the exploitative and hierarchical caste system. With his holistic vision and systematic reforms, Guru Ghasidas contributed significantly in removing the prevailing social injustice and inequality.

Satnam Panth believes that truth is God and there is only one God, which is formless (nirgun) and infinite (anant). Individual reformation was brought by prohibiting consumption of liquor and non-vegetarian food. Guru Ghasidas also formulated principles, which show his love for fauna and his desire to put an end to cruelty towards animals. The partisans of Satnam Panth have been following these dictates from last hundreds of years now.

After its upgradation into a central university, many steps have been taken by the University authorities to translate Guruji's philosophy into reality. Now, our campus is an alcohol and tobacco free campus. Our vibrant university campus, where students from diverse castes, creeds and classes come together from all over India, provides an egalitarian environment based on Guruji's teachings.

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ABOUT THE VISHWAVIDYALAYA

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (GGV), a Central University established by the Central Universities Act 2009 of the Parliament, was originally established as State University by an Act of State Legislative Assembly of the then undivided Madhya Pradesh on 16th June 1983. GGV is an active member of the Association of Indian Universities and Association of Commonwealth University. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has accredited the University as B.

Situated in a socially and economically challenged area, the University is appropriately named to honour the great Satnami Saint Guru Ghasidas (born in 17th century), who championed the cause of the downtrodden and waged a relentless struggle against all forms of social evils and injustice prevailing in the society.

The University is a semi-residential institution. The University covers almost the total spectrum of higher education in 32 university teaching departments offering various courses in the areas of Arts, Commerce, Education, Engineering and Technology, Humanities, Life Sciences, Management, Pharmacy, Sciences and Social Sciences. The lush green sprawling campus of the University spread over an area of aprox. 655 acres is located 05 KM away from the main Bilaspur City, in Koni village. River Arpa, the lifeline of Bilaspur, runs parallel to the University campus. Bilaspur is a fast Industrializing City, already having a large number of industrial units coming up in the region. The area is the nerve center of trade in iron and steel, coal, aluminium, textiles, foodgrains, Kosa silk, cement, paper, furniture and jewellery and is internationally known for its rice production.



Candidates are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess at least the minimum essential qualifications laid down in the advertisement.

Mere appearance in the Entrance Test or securing pass marks at the test does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission to the Programme unless he/she fulfils the Programme wise eligibility conditions. APPLICANTS MUST FULLY SATISFY THEMSELVES ABOUT THEIR programme wise ELIGIBILITY AS PRESCRIBED in the ADMISSION BROCHURE, BEFORE FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM.

If an applicant is inadvertently allowed to appear at the Entrance Test who otherwise does not meet the minimum course wise eligibility requirements, he/she cannot, at a later date, use that as a right to claim that he/she meets the eligibility requirements.

Number of seats for B. Ed. Special Education (HI & LD) are tentative. Seats will be filled only after its approval from RCI.

- Possession of weapons.

Disciplinary Actions

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur invites online applications for admission to the various programmes for the Academic Session 2023-24 through Common University Entrance Test CUET 2023 to be conducted by NTA.

For Foreign Nationals policy of admission is attached separately.

Guidelines for submission of online application form as notified by NTA are available separately on https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/. It is suggested to the applicants that before submitting online application forms read the instructions carefully. Mere appearance in the CUET UG 2023 or inclusion of name in the merit list does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission to a course unless he/she fulfils the prescribed eligibility conditions for that programme.

Age should not be more than **22 years for Under Graduate Programmes** and **25 years for Post Graduate Programmes** as on 1-July-2023. For M.P.Ed. Programme, the upper age limit is **28 years**. There will be no upper age limit for B.Ed. & M.Ed./BA-LLB/B. Com LLB Programmes.

Date of Entrance Test, Test method, Application fee, Entrance Test centre, Syllabus for Entrance Test, Admission procedure etc. will be notified by National Testing Agency (NTA) from time to time and the same may be uploaded on the University website www.ggu.ac.in. Therefore, it is suggested to all applicants that they have to visit NTA website, CUET 2023 links and www.ggu.ac.in regularly.



Admission Details

RELAXATION IN MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR SC, ST & PWD CATEGORIES

All SC, ST & PWD candidates who have passed the qualifying examination are eligible to appear in the entrance examination irrespective of their percentage of marks.

RELAXATION IN UPPER AGE LIMIT FOR SC, ST, OBC & PWD CATEGORIES

There is age relaxation of 5 years for SC, ST & PWD candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates for admissions in various courses in upper age limit wherever the upper age limit is prescribed.

Relaxation for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants in admission based on the instruction of UGC/MoE.

If the candidates' aggregate percentage of marks in the qualifying examination is below the stipulated minimum percentage of aggregate marks, his/her provisional admission will also stand automatically cancelled and the candidate will not be entitled to claim refund of fees.

Fee once paid to the University will not be refunded fully to the applicant. It will be refunded to the candidates only after necessary deductions as stipulated in GGV Ordinances.

Nomenclature and duration of the UG programmes may be modified by the University in accordance with NEP 2020.
