Under the guidance of Prof. Alok Kumar Chakrawal, the Vice Chancellor of Guru Ghasida Central University, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh, the Department of Forestry organized a one-day awareness and training program on environmental activities and Miyawaki plantation under Consultancy Project awarded to Dr Ajay Kumar Singh, Assistant Professor, Department of Forestry, GGV, Bilaspur at Thriveni Sainik Mining Pvt. Ltd. in Barkagaon, Hazaribagh, Jharkhand. A total of 35 individual participated in this program.

The workshop commenced with an inaugural address by the coordinator, Dr. Ajay Kumar Singh, Assistant Professor in the Department of Forestry at Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya. Dr. Singh emphasized the crucial role of the environment in our daily lives and elaborated on Miyawaki plantation, its methodology, and the associated benefits. Dr. Ajay Kumar Srivastava, Resource person & Head of the Department of Botany at St. Xavier's College, Ranchi, Jharkhand, discussed environmental safety and simple adjustments that individuals can make to contribute to environmental conservation, such as using cloth bags instead of plastic and conserving energy by turning off power when not needed. Another resource person, Mr. Ravish Kumar, the Environment Manager at Thriveni Sainik Mining Pvt. Ltd., provided valuable information to the participants on conserving the environment and outlined steps for sustainable environmental development.

The training program concluded with a field visit to the Miyawaki plantation site, a collaborative effort between the Department of Forestry, Wildlife, and Environmental Sciences and Thriveni Sainik Mining Pvt. Ltd.
