Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya is named after Saint Guru Ghasidas (1756-1836), a visionary social reformer. Guru Ghasidas founded Satnam Panth, a socio-religious sect, which challenged contemporary discriminatory social order and advocated for social equality by refuting the exploitative and hierarchical caste system. With his holistic vision and systematic reforms, Guru Ghasidas contributed significantly in removing the prevailing social injustice and inequality.

Satnam Panth believes that truth is God and there is only one God, which is formless (nirgun) and infinite (anant). Individual reformation was brought by prohibiting consumption of liquor and non-vegetarian food. Guru Ghasidas also formulated principles, which show his love for fauna and his desire to put an end to cruelty towards animals. The partisans of Satnam Panth have been following these dictates from last hundreds of years now.

After its upgradation into a central university, many steps have been taken by the University authorities to translate Guruji's philosophy into reality. Now, our campus is an alcohol and tobacco free campus. Our vibrant university campus, where students from diverse castes, creeds and classes come together from all over India, provides an egalitarian environment based on Guruji's teachings.





- This program reflects the university's commitment to social responsibility, ensuring that the needs of elderly individuals are met through timely and compassionate support from student volunteers.




Misconduct

- Any act on the part of the students, which disrupts functioning of the university, endangers health and safety of campus residents and damages Vishwavidyalaya properties.
- Cheating in examination and supplying of false documents / information in order to seek any consideration / favour from the University.
- Possession or consumption of intoxicating beverages on the campus.
- Failure to return back loaned material, settle University dues.
- Possession of weapons.
- Use of unparliamentarily language while in conversation with Vishwavidyalaya Staff and fellow students.

Disciplinary Actions

Failure to adhere to good conduct may result in disciplinary actions like :

- A warning by the authorities.
- Suspension from a particular class.
- Suspension / expulsion from the University.
- Suspension of campus privileges e.g. hostel, accommodation etc.
- Withholding of examination result or withdrawal of awarded diploma / degree certificate.
- Any other disciplinary action deemed appropriate by the University authorities.

Admission Procedure / General Instructions

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur invites online applications for admission to the various programmes for the Academic Session 2024-25 through Common University Entrance Test CUET 2024 to be conducted by NTA.

For Foreign Nationals policy of admission is attached separately.

Guidelines for submission of online application form as notified by NTA are available separately on <https://cuetsamarth.ac.in/>. It is suggested to the applicants that before submitting online application forms read the instructions carefully. Mere appearance in the CUET UG 2024 or inclusion of name in the merit list does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission to a course unless he/she fulfils the prescribed eligibility conditions for that programme.

Age should not be more than **22 years for Under Graduate Programmes** and **25 years for Post Graduate Programmes** as on 1-July-2024. For M.P.Ed. Programme, the upper age limit is **28 years**. There will be no upper age limit for B.Ed. & M.Ed./BA-LLB/B. Com LLB Programmes.

Date of Entrance Test, Test method, Application fee, Entrance Test centre, Syllabus for Entrance Test, Admission procedure etc. will be notified by National Testing Agency (NTA) from time to time and the same may be uploaded on the University website www.ggu.ac.in. Therefore, it is suggested to all applicants that they have to visit NTA website, CUET 2024 links and www.ggu.ac.in regularly.



Admission Details

RELAXATION IN MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR SC, ST & PWD CATEGORIES

All SC, ST & PWD candidates who have passed the qualifying examination are eligible to appear in the entrance examination irrespective of their percentage of marks.

RELAXATION IN UPPER AGE LIMIT FOR SC, ST, OBC & PWD CATEGORIES

There is age relaxation of 5 years for SC, ST & PWD candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates for admissions in various courses in upper age limit wherever the upper age limit is prescribed.

Relaxation for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants in admission based on the instruction of UGC/MoE.

If the candidates' aggregate percentage of marks in the qualifying examination is below the stipulated minimum percentage of aggregate marks, his/her provisional admission will also stand automatically cancelled and the candidate will not be entitled to claim refund of fees.

Fee once paid to the University will not be refunded fully to the applicant. It will be refunded to the candidates only after necessary deductions as stipulated in GGVS Ordinances.

Nomenclature and duration of the UG programmes may be modified by the University in accordance with NEP 2020.
