Eligibility

- 1. Faculty members of political science, social work, economics, history, law, iournalism working in universities and colleges that are included under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, even though they may not yet be fit under Section 12 (B), may be invited to participate in the orientation and refresher courses. The teachers of colleges that do not yet come within the purview of Section 2(f). but have been affiliated to a university for at least five years, will be permitted to participate in the courses.
- 2. Part-time / Ad-hoc/ temporary / contract teachers who have been teaching for at least three academic sessions in an institution without differentiating them on the basis of

type of management, which has been affiliated to a University programme / Refresher Course to enhance their skills.

- 3. University/ College teachers those already attended orientation programme or Refresher Course are eligible to attend a Refresher Course after a minimum gap of one year.
- Selection will be made as per the guidelines of the UGC-HRDC and on first come first serve basis.
