About ANVESHAN-2023

With a view to inculcating research culture in our Higher Education Institutions, the Research Division of Association of Indian Universities has taken a pioneering initiative to organize Student Research Conventions for the aspiring researchers throughout the Country. These Conventions aims at identifying the young and rising talents who would be promoted through proper encouragement and incentives. Also, an attempt shall be made to commercialize their research projects by providing a structure avenue for industrial collaboration. The endeavour may accelerate scientific research and innovation and their application towards community development percolating to the grass root level. ANVESHAN is guided by two principal objectives: firstly, to identify young researchers with research aptitude and interest and to motivate and support them for taking research as a career option; secondly to identify fresh talents with unconventional and innovative ideas and channelize them into research that would contribute to creating a solid core of knowledge workers and simultaneously solving the day to day problems by finding dynamic and possible solutions.

Objectives of ANVESHAN-2023

- The primary goal of AIU-ANVESHAN is to provide a platform for researchers, scholars, and innovators to present their cutting-edge research findings.
- The convention provides an avenue for participants from diverse fields to interact, exchange ideas, and explore the possibilities of cross-disciplinary research and innovation.
- By highlighting practical applications of research, ANVESHAN encourages attendees to think beyond theory and engage with real-world problems.
- It encourages participants to connect with peers, experts, and potential collaborators, fostering a community of researchers and innovators.
- To provide proper incentives to enhance the skill of potential students. To initiate an intensive research culture in a selected group of institutions.

Research Tracks

The research areas/fields in which Projects (Individual and Group Projects) are invited are;

- Agricultural Science
- Basic Sciences
- Engineering and Technology
- Health Sciences
- Social Sciences
- Interdisciplinary

Projects on above mentioned areas must be original and must have undergone some exploration/ground work in order to show its feasibility and impact. The participants can present their research projects individually or in a group having a maximum of four members.

Structure of ANVESHAN-2023

The ANVESHAN-2023 will be held in four phases:

- 1. The first phase consists of competition at the School Level of GGV. In the first phase, top three research projects will be selected from the participants of each school. The projects will be based on the research areas proposed in ANVESHAN-2023. The projects will be scrutinized by the team of experts. School level competition will be conducted by the respective schools.
- 2.In the second phase, the projects selected from each school will compete at the University level, based on which six research project will be selected (One from each track of ANVESHAN 2023) as per the guidelines of AIU. This second stage at university level is proposed to be scheduled at 5th October 2023.
- 3. The third phase consists of the Zonal Level in which the projects selected from second phase will participate. The last date to register for the zonal level is 20th October 2023. Winners of zonal level will participate in the National Convention.
- 4. The fourth phase is the National Level Convention in which the winners from each zone will participate. Three projects from each track will be selected in the National Convention.

Criteria for Project Assessment

The projects will be assessed by the panel of experts on the basis of cumulative weightage given on all the following criteria:


- Scientific Thoughts and Principles 20
- Creativity- 20
- Thoroughness- 10
- Skill- 10
- Relevance-20
- Cost Effectiveness- 10
- Teamwork-10

In case of the projects having scored equal cumulative weightage, 'Scope of Commercialization' will be considered as an additional merit for making the final decision

Awards and Incentives

- Individuals/Groups participating in second phase(university level) will be given 'Certificate of Appreciation' from Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur.
- The winners at the zonal level and national level will be awarded as per AIU norms.

Mode of Presentation



- The ANVESHAN-2023 will be organized in offline mode.
- The projects can be presented in the form of models / poster / oral presentation in any aforementioned areas / fields.
- All the participants giving poster presentation should bring the hard copies of their poster to present infront of the panel of experts/judges.
- Total time allotted for poster / oral / model presentation is 10 minutes. Seven minutes for presentation and Three minutes for question and answers.
- In case of Group Project, only one member will allowed for giving presentation.
- The decision of the panel of experts / judges will be final and binding on all the participants.

Registration Fees

There is NO registration fee to participate in first and second phases of ANVESHAN-2023 and for zonal and national level team/participants has to pay registration fee as per AIU norms.

Eligibility for Participation

Entries of research projects will be purely institutional and only bonafide full time Undergraduate (UG), Postgraduate (PG), Researchers and Scholars from various disciplines of GGV can participate in this research competition.

Important Dates

- School Level Competition: Will be decided by respective schools Coordinator and Dean. It must be completed on or before 30th September 2023
- University Level Competition: 05th October 2023
- Last Date of Registration for Zonal Level Competition: 20th October 2023
