## 1. Preamble/About Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (GGV)

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (GGV) a Central University of India, is situated in Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh. It was established under the Central Universities Act, 2009 (No. 25 of 2009), transitioning from its earlier status as Guru Ghasidas University (GGU), which was founded through an Act of the State Legislative Assembly and formally inaugurated on June 16, 1983.

An active member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) and the Association of Commonwealth Universities (ACU), GGV is deeply rooted in its mission to serve the community in a socially and economically disadvantaged region. The university derives its name from the revered Satnami Saint Guru Ghasidas, who lived during the 17th century. Guru Ghasidas was a beacon of hope for the oppressed, leading a tireless struggle against social evils and injustice, and advocating for equality and human dignity. His legacy inspires the university's ethos and commitment to education and empowerment.

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (GGV) has achieved remarkable milestones, underscoring its commitment to academic excellence and institutional growth. It proudly holds the prestigious NAAC A++ accreditation and has been recognised as a Category 1 University under the University Grants Commission's (UGC) Graded Autonomy framework. GGV's global standing is further affirmed by its impressive 263rd position in the QS (Quacquarelli Symonds) World University Rankings. These accolades, among others, reflect the university's firm dedication to promoting innovation, quality education, and impactful research on both national and international platforms.

### II.Project Justification: Advancing Equity through DACE

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (A Central University), Bilaspur proposes to offer coaching for Civil Services Exams (CSE) to students of GGV and beyond. GGV, located in a Schedule 5 tribal-dominated region of Chhattisgarh, serves as a critical academic hub for the socioeconomically disadvantaged and marginalized communities, including Scheduled Castes (SC),

Scheduled Tribes (ST), and Other Backward Classes (OBC). The introduction of DACE aligns seamlessly with the university's commitment to social equity, empowerment, and academic excellence. As part of its core mission, the Dr. Ambedkar Centre of Excellence (DACE) at GGV will offer free, high-quality coaching for Civil Services Examinations (CSE)/UGC-CSIR NET/GATE etc. to students not only from GGV but also from the wider region. This initiative reflects the vision of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, who believed that true empowerment comes through access to governance and administrative roles. By equipping students with the skills, mentorship, and resources necessary to succeed in one of the most prestigious and competitive examinations in the country. The Centre will provide structured and specialized coaching to students for various competitive examinations, including Civil Services, Judicial Services, and other central/state-level recruitment tests, UGC-CSIR NET/GATE etc. thereby enhancing their representation in administrative, academics and leadership roles.

# III- Aims and Objectives of Dr. Ambedkar Centre of Excellence, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (DACE-GGV)

The aim of the Dr. Ambedkar Centre of Excellence (DACE) is to offer free, high-quality coaching for Civil Services and other competitive exams to students. Its goal is to increase their representation in public services and promote social inclusion through education, empowerment, and equal opportunities.

The specific objectives of DACE-GGV are;

- To provide quality coaching for students preparing for Civil Services, UGC-CSIR NET,
   GATE, and other competitive exams, focusing on key subjects and smart exam strategies.
- To offer the right infrastructure and learning resources that support effective preparation and increase success rates.
- To build student's confidence and motivation, inspiring them to pursue careers in administration, academics, and leadership.

## IV Academic Action Plan

#### V- Admission Criteria, Eligibility, Subjects, Faculty, and Resources

#### a. Admission

- 1. The minimum qualification for admission to the DACE-GGV shall be the passing of under graduate conducted by the recognized University. 80% of the seats will be reserved for students of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya. The candidate shall be eligible for admission on the basis of the merit list of Common Entrance Test/Merit of Graduate course or any other procedure decided by Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya for Admission to DACE-GGV time to time.
- 2. Students will be expected to pay a fee of Rs. 500/- per month for General Category students, and Rs. 250 for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/Women students.
- 3. At the time of admission, Rs. 100 will be charged as admission fees.

#### b. Eligibility Criteria for Students

- 1. To be considered for admission to DACE-GGV in the desired subject, candidates must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying examination.
- 2. The scheme is open to all students in the age group of 20 years (Minimum) to 31 years (Maximum), respectively.
- 3. The coaching benefits under the scheme may only be utilised by a student ONCE, regardless of the number of chances that he/she may be entitled to in a particular Competitive Examination. The student must submit to the University an affidavit stating that he/she has not received any monetary benefit from any of the other schemes by the Government of India, State/UTs or any funding agency.
- 4. The candidates enrolled under this scheme shall have to attend all the classes. In case of remaining absent for more than 15 days without any valid reason, or leaving the coaching midway,the admission of the student will be cancelled.
- 5. A total of hundred seats (100) sanctioned for coaching. 33% of the total sanctioned seats for coaching may preferably be given to the eligible female candidates. In case a sufficient number of eligible female candidates do not apply, the University may allocate the vacant seats to the male candidates.
- 6. GGV DACE will maintain Attendance Registers for all candidates enrolled for the coaching classes, as well as subject-wise results of practice tests, or any other evaluation.

#### c. Subjects offered

The University will be providing coaching to the students for the examinations conducted by UPSC/UGC-CSIR NET/GATE etc. The subject taught will include General studies, Reasoning, Qualitative and Quantitative aptitude and the subjects opted by the candidates, including humanities, arts, social sciences and science.

## d. Nodal Officer, Coordinators, Teaching FacultiesHiring, Remuneration

- (i) The University's Competent Authority shall appoint a Nodal Officer for DACE-GGV for a minimum period of three years. The Nodal Officer must be a permanent faculty member of the University and will handle this as an additional responsibility without any extra monetary benefits. The roles and responsibilities will be defined by the University.
- (ii) The Competent Authority shall also appoint one Coordinator and two Co-coordinators for each coaching course offered under DACE, such as UPSC, UGC-CSIR NET, GATE, or any other.
- (iii) The University may engage its faculty members from Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya to deliver lectures on a clock hour basis, with a remuneration of Rs. 500 per one-hour lecture.
- (iv) DACE may also invite guest lecturers from reputed institutions outside GGV. They will be paid Rs. 1000 for a one-hour lecture or Rs. 2000 for a two-hour lecture, inclusive of all travel and other expenses.

#### e. Manpower Required

The following personnel will be required to execute the DACE-GGV smoothly;

- (i). Nodal Officer
- (ii). Coordinators
- (iii).One LDC cum computer operator
- (iv). One MTS

## VI- Operational Framework and Key Features of DACE

- Student Performance Records: All student achievements, test results, and evaluation reports will be meticulously maintained to track progress and identify areas for improvement.
- Training Delivery Mode: Coaching will be delivered through a mix of online and offline classes, utilizing lecture formats enhanced with audio/video aids and online resources. Study materials will be provided in both digital and physical formats.
- Regular Assessments and Interactive Sessions: Students' progress will be monitored regularly through assessments, including questionnaires and tests. To inspire and guide the aspirants, interactive sessions with successful candidates and administrative officers will be conducted, along with motivational talks. Additionally, soft skills training will be integrated through specially designed programs. The coaching sessions will typically be held for two hours, with a maximum duration of four hours, scheduled in the afternoon or evening.
- Success Rate Target:DACE aims to achieve a high success rate, with an initial target of
  at least 10% success in UPSC examinations, backed by continuous assessment and
  monitoring systems.
- Practice Resources: Practice papers, worksheets, and other study aids will be provided to students to facilitate regular practice and exam readiness.
- Infrastructure Support: The university will offer essential infrastructure, including a Classroom with audiovisual aids, internet and computer facilities, electricity supply, maintenance, etc., to support candidates in their preparation.
- Counselling and Motivation: Continuous counselling and motivational support will be
  provided to candidates by trained counsellors to keep them engaged and focused
  throughout their preparation journey.

#### VI Financial Assistance Required.

A dedicated account will be opened for GGV-DACE, with the Nodal Officer, Registrar, and Finance Officer designated as authorized signatories. The account will be operated jointly by any two of the three signatories.
