There were three Competitions lined for all the students of university on 8th April, 2025 at the department of law. These were-

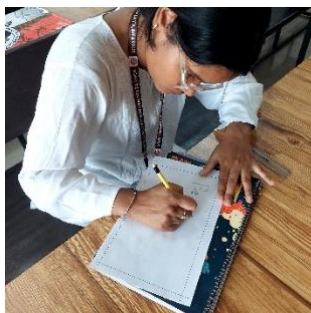
1. Poster Making Competition on theme "Equal Opportunities for all"

Further, Dr. Bharti Ahirwar Mam presented her thoughts and inspired the younger generations for making positive impact towards Gender Equality in Present and Future.

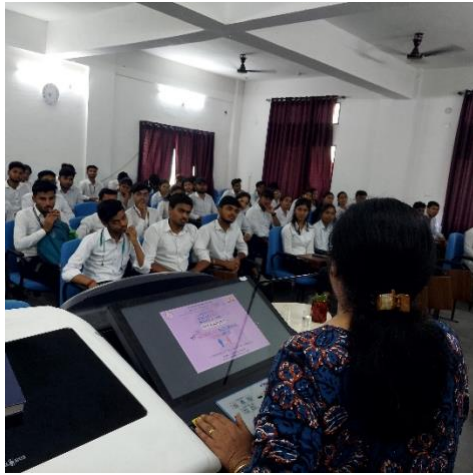
Then the prize distribution ceremony was started and all the dignitaries were called upon to Felicitate the winners of the various competitions held on day 2.
